How do new kids get started?

New sailors learn in small and easy Optimist dinghies, which are used all over the world to introduce kids to sailing. The basics of boat handling and safety are taught in a fun, yet safe and supportive environment. Within days kids will be skippering an "Opti".

What if we don't have a boat?

It's easy to charter one of HYC's Optis at the same time you register (available on a first-come-first-served basis). If needed, we also can assist you in finding a charter Laser, Blue Jay or Opti from a private owner or dealer.

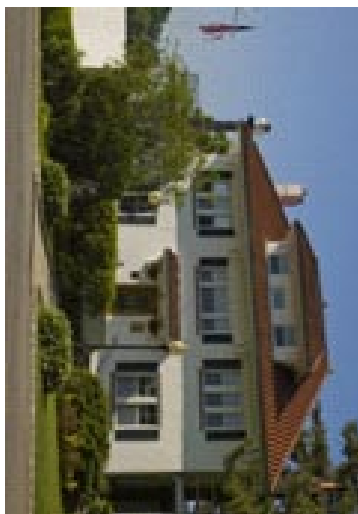


Where do we sail?

Beginners start in the sheltered waters behind Glen Island and then sail within a few hundred yards of the shore. Experienced sailors, accompanied by our instructors, are able to explore other parts of New Rochelle's waterfront, sail to HYC's private island and can attend regattas at other local Clubs.

What makes HYC's program special?

HYC was a founding member of the JSA in 1926. We observe yachting traditions, and train and support our junior sailors to attend local JSA regattas. HYC's program is also just right for kids who want to be out on the water with friends. The program is full day, which leaves plenty of time for instruction, games, contests, swimming and fun.

HYC Tradition

Sailing and boating are sports to be enjoyed throughout a lifetime. The Huguenot Yacht Club hosts a **junior sailing program** each summer that builds proficiency, creates friendships and, inspires a life-long love of the sport. The HYC program **combines fun with learning**, not only how to sail and race - but also how to do your best, work as a team, and understand our maritime environment.

The Program is held Monday through Friday from 9-4 daily with lunch included.

We accommodate sailors of all levels. Our students include beginners who have never sailed, returning intermediates, and avid racers (who attend local regattas). The typical day includes **rigging boats, sailing, practice racing, and instruction** on the water and in the classroom.

We enjoy good old-fashioned summertime fun and games. There is **swimming** in the **HYC pool** each day. During each session there is both a "Big Boat" day where juniors sail aboard a large sailboat for a day of fun, and a small regatta for sailors to compete for prizes.



We maintain a **low student to instructor ratio, so please register early**. Enrollment is limited to 40 children and teens between the ages of 8 and 16. If you don't own a boat, contact us, to discuss **boats available for charter** which are offered on a first come, first served basis.

Registration & Open Houses

Sunday, January 29 (3-5 pm): Registration for **program alumni and Huguenot members**. Alumni/Club members have priority registration until February 11, 2012. Applications are posted on the website and can be mailed in, too.

Sundays, February 12 & March 11 (both 4-6 pm): **Open Houses**. Tour the Clubhouse, and see our docks and boats. Ask questions and meet some of our staff and alumni.

New Sailor Registration begins on February 12. Applications are available at Open Houses, online and can be mailed in.

Pre-Session Clinics: June 26-29

New sailors who want to get a head start can join our **Introduction to Sailing Clinic**. This clinic is a great opportunity for those who just want to try out the program. An Opti charter is included in the low Clinic price. We also offer a **Racing Clinic** for experienced sailors. Both clinics are optional and run from June 26-29 (Tues. - Fri.) The clinics are full day (9-4 pm) and include lunch and pool time, too!



Regular Sessions: July 2–Aug. 10 (Choose 3 weeks or all 6 weeks)

Our two regular Sessions are full day (9-4 pm). Sailors are divided into beginner, intermediate and advanced/laser groups. Session I runs from **July 2 through July 20** (no Program on July 4th) Session II runs from **July 23 through August 10**. Celebrations with our Junior Sailing families include our annual BBQ, held at the end of Session I, and our Awards Dinner held during the last week of Session II. Other fun activities are being planned, too!
